9. Sylabus zajęć w języku angielskim:

Course aims:

Classes are prepared to cover the detailed pathophysiology of multiple diseases affecting human organism. Case-based presentations explain the pathogenesis of homeostatic imbalances and mechanisms leading to formation of morphologic changes in affected organs and systems.

Seminar 1 – Neoplasia

- Nomenclature and characteristics of benign and malignant neoplasms.

- Neoplasm development and malignant phenotype: abnormal signal transduction, examples of carcinogens and carcinogenesis, tumor growth and development, mechanism of metastasis, TNM classification.
- Pathophysiology of malignant disease, paraneoplastic syndromes and cachexia.

Seminar 2 – Inflammation

- Pathophysiological and molecular mechanisms of inflammatory response
- Elevated body temperature and fever. Pathophysiology and phases of fever
- Acute phase response and proteins

Seminar 3 – Endocrine disorders

- Disturbances of the pituitary gland, the thyroid gland, the parathyroid gland, the suprarenal gland
- Disturbances of the suprarenal gland, gonads
- Pathogenesis of stress reaction

Seminar 4 - Diabetes Mellitus

- IDDM and NIDDM pathogenesis
- Secondary diabetes pathogenesis
- Acute and chronic diabetic complications (diabetic ketoacidosis, Hyperosmolar nonketotic coma, Lactic acidosis, Diabetic nephropathy, neuropathy and retinopathy, diabetic foot)

Seminar 5 - Pathophysiology of Kidneys

- Pre-renal, renal and post-renal acute renal failure.
- Chronic renal failure and End-stage renal disease. Renal osteodystrophy. Uremic encephalopathy.
- Proteinuria.
- Nephrotic syndrome

Course objectives:

Knowledge:

Students should learn to explain pathophysiological mechanisms underlying morphological changes and clinical symptoms seen in patient organism.

Skills:

Ability to use the theoretical knowledge about pathomechanisms of diseases to plan diagnostic and therapeutic process in clinical practice.

Attitudes and transferrable (generic) competencies:

Students understand the need for continuous self-improvement to the rapid progress of biomedical sciences. Demonstrate awareness of the importance of knowledge of the pathological processes and demonstrate a willingness to use this knowledge for educational purposes. Students are prepared to cooperate in a team to solve clinical problems.
